

AMENDMENT TO REINFORCE THE ENFORCEMENT

- Set out the assumptions relating to creation of electronic signature to be consistent with actual practice and rules newly prescribed in UN Convention on the Use of Electronic Communications in International Contracts
- Provide that the Office of Electronic Transactions Development Agency be the key agency responsible for supervision of electronic transactions business, as no any other agencies take care of this task.
- Adjust the rules on the supervision of electronic transactions businesses to be more appropriate and comprehensive
- Adjust the components and authorities of the Electronic Transactions
 Commission to be in line with the tasks in driving Thailand's economy through digital technology.

PREPARATION AND ACCOMMODATION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON THE USE OF ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS IN INTERNATIONAL CONTRACTS

- Set out the legal effect of a contract made via automatic data system.
- Provide that an offer made in electronic form which is not sent to any specific person to be merely invitation to make an offer.
- · Set out the legal effect of an input error obligation of data massage

Integration of agencies responsible for carrying out tasks facilitating the mission of Electronic Transactions Commission in promoting e-Transactions & e-Commerce in Thailand

- Establish the National Electronic Transactions Development Agency :
 - To facilitate operational tasks promoting electronics transactions in various areas, including trades, investments, import- export or governmental services and
 - To be responsible for operational tasks relating to soft infrastructure in a view to the development of our nation's digital economy.
